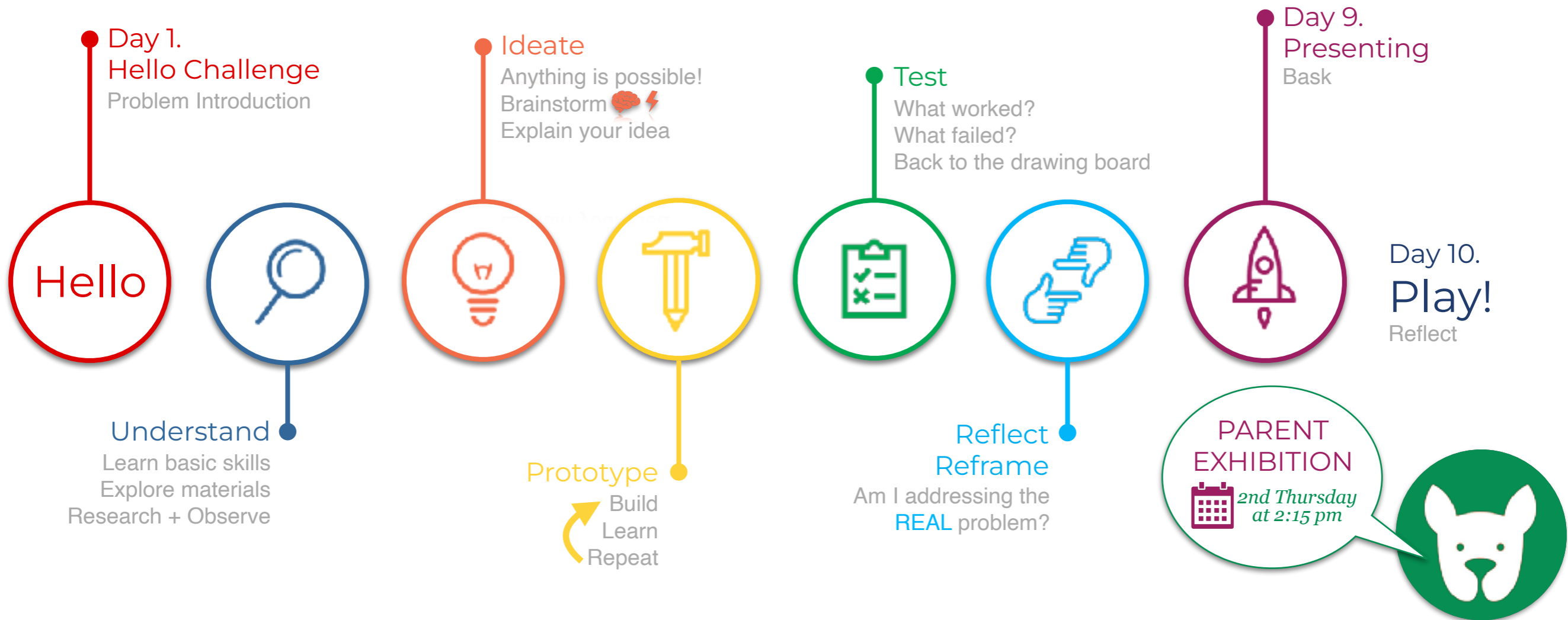

PICK-UP & DROP-OFF

Morning Drop-Off is at 9:15 am and Afternoon Pick-Up at 3:15 pm. It is imperative that you do not block the driveway. Andrus requires that emergency vehicles have clear passage at all times. At pick-up and drop off staff will help queue cars and will escort your child to and from the curbside of your car; parents are asked not to leave their cars. If you expect your child may need more than a quick good-bye from you then please park your car in a spot in the lower parking lot and walk with them to the drop-off area. There is a map on the next page and more specific information regarding your child's group and pick-up/drop off location will be provided prior to camp.

EXTENDED DAY CARE

Extended day drop-off will be at the traffic circle. Parents may pick up their child at any time prior to 4:15 by walking to the Hudson Lab School entrance which is at the rear of the building. If you have any questions, please contact us at camp@hudsonlabschool.com or (914) 826-5586.

DROP-OFF & PICK-UP

A Our youngest campers, as well as any older siblings, will be dropped off and picked up from A, at the top of the traffic circle and parents are encouraged to enter and exit Andrus via the main drive, not through the lower parking lots.

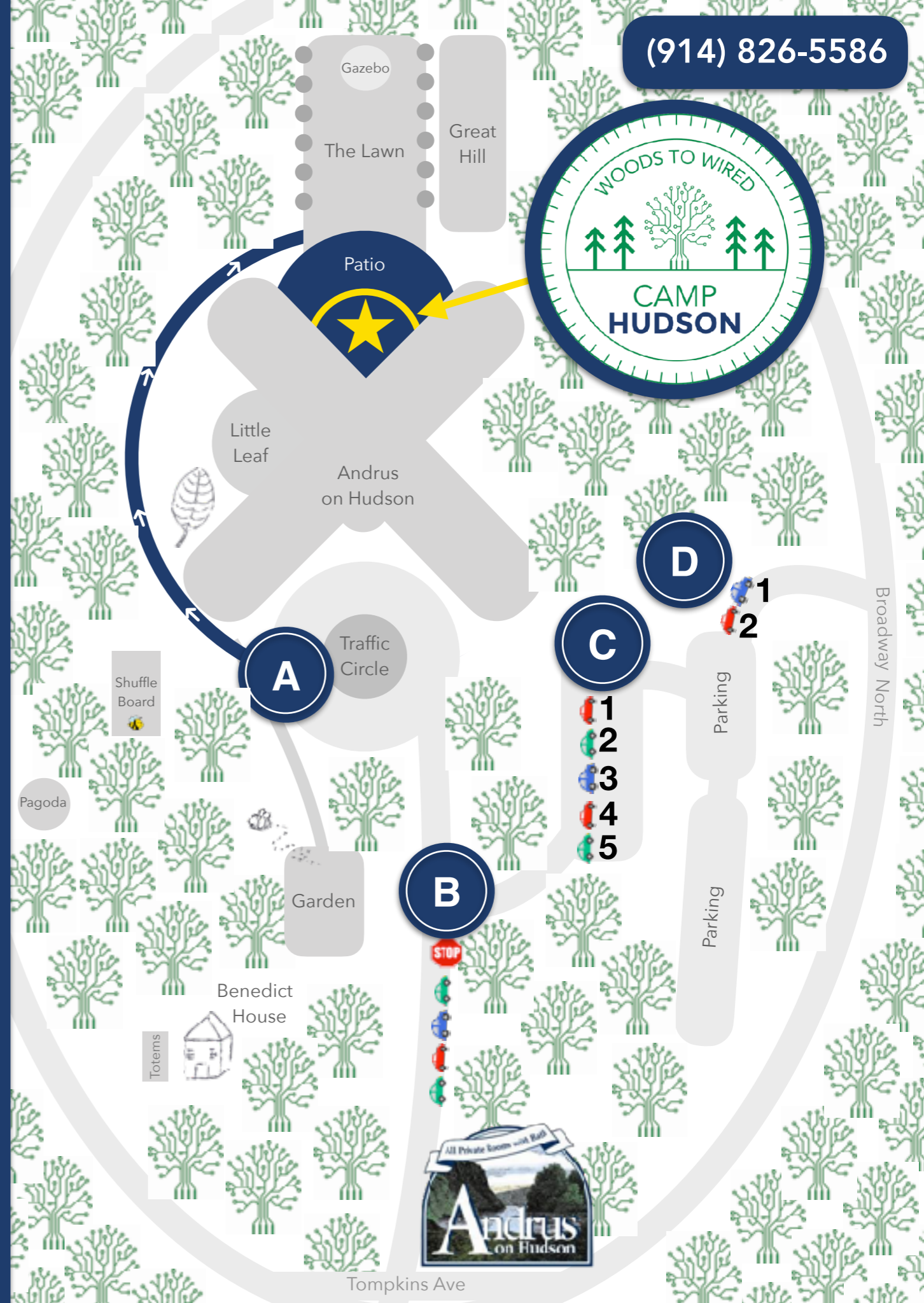
ALL OTHER CAMPERS:

B Staff will queue cars at point B.

C No more than 5 cars at a time will be allowed to line-up along the left side in parking area C so that Andrus staff and people visiting residents are able to pass freely.

D As cars pull up to the grassy area marked D, counselors will escort campers to their cars on the curbside, we ask that you please move quickly through the process so that those waiting behind you may collect their children.

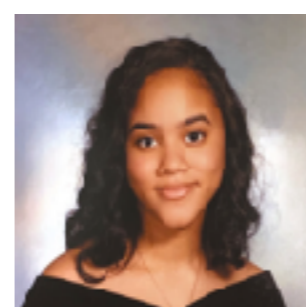

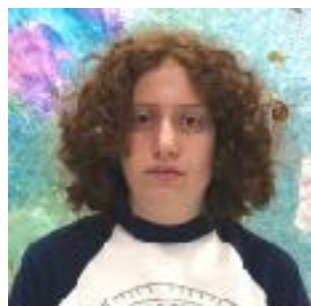

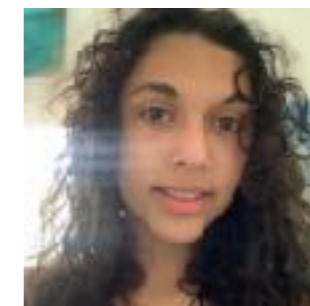
